



# 2009 Summer Faculty Development Grant

## FACULTY DEVELOPMENT GRANT APPLICATION

POSTMARK DEADLINE: MARCH 16, 2009

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### ELIGIBILITY

All full-time teaching faculty in appropriate academic programs at two- and four-year institutions are eligible. Selected recipients must be available for an interview with the cooperating NATPE member company. Upon completion of the "internship," recipients will be expected to submit a detailed description/evaluation of the experience, or an article relating to the experience for publication. Grant recipients are responsible for their own transportation, accommodations and meals.

A \$500 per week stipend will be paid to grant recipients for up to six weeks of FDG experience. The stipend will be paid after the FDG experience has been completed and the grant report has been submitted. Grant reports are due within 45 days of completion of the grant experience.

### APPLICATIONS AND DEADLINES

To apply, eligible faculty must submit three copies of the following:

- A completed application form (following two pages)
- A brief, written statement indicating areas of particular interest and why/how a summer experience in the programming industry will improve effectiveness in the classroom
- A letter of support from the department chairperson or academic dean
- A brief description of the school and the department, including the number of full-time students, the number of majors in the department and the types of courses offered
- A one page description of your personal television habits and preferences.
